Distinguished Chapter Advisor Team Awards

A chapter may nominate their advisor team of two or more for this award. The advisors should demonstrate an exceptional atmosphere of teamwork, leadership abilities, promotion of Phi Theta Kappa programming and other engagement in the Society, and enthusiasm for the Society's Hallmarks. Advisors nominated for this award may also be nominated for other individual advisor awards. Chapter advisor teams are eligible to win this award every other year.

Advisor Individual Awards

Award-winning advisors are those who make significant contributions to the growth of the individual members, serve as the chapter's advocate on campus, and encourage the chapter to be involved on the local, regional and/or international levels of the organization. Years of service will be based upon the advisor's start date reported to Phi Theta Kappa Headquarters.

Paragon Awards for New Advisors - Advisors with less than four years of service as of January 13, 2021. An advisor may receive this award only once.

Distinguished Advisor Awards - Advisors with at least four or more years of service as of January 13, 2021. An advisor may receive this award only once

Continued Excellence Awards for Advisors - Advisors must have already received the Distinguished Advisor Award. Once an advisor has received the Distinguished Advisor Award, they will be eligible for the Continued Excellence Award for Advisors the following year. Advisors are eligible to win this award every other year.
